Capturing an exchange of aggression and tenderness, capturing the exchange of play fighting transitioning to real fighting. Untangling unwanted thoughts and other personal mental and physical health issues. Our reward mechanisms that fine-tune this balance In snow, on the prairie. In isolation.

Relevant in our times of this pandemic. Where Isolation and existential fear are prevalent.
